## **WATER CONSERVATION MANDATE UPDATE**

### **EFFECTIVE FEBRUARY 14, 2023**

Per the Governor's Executive Order N-7-22 and the State Water Resources Control Board Emergency Regulations, the following water use restrictions will commence on February 14, 2023:

- All landscape irrigation limited to no more than 2 days per week from June 1<sup>st</sup> to October 31<sup>st</sup> and no more than 1 day per week from Nov 1<sup>st</sup> to May 31<sup>st</sup>
- No landscape irrigation between 10 am to 8 pm
- All landscape irrigation limited to no more than 10 minutes per station per watering day
- Excess irrigation runoff is prohibited
- No landscape irrigation during or within 48 hours of a rain event
- No washing of sidewalks/driveways with water
- Car washing only with bucket or a hose with a shutoff valve or nozzle
- Repair or isolate leaks within 48 hours of notification by the City
- Cease all operation of decorative water features (fountains, ponds, etc.) with the exceptions for those decorative fountains lakes or ponds that use pumps to recirculate water and only require refilling to replace evaporative losses.
