



CONSERVE TODAY – PRESERVE TOMORROW

Effective June 5, 2023, Governor Newsom has eased some drought restrictions and maintained others to support impacted communities and continue to build water resilience.

The actions identified below are intended to **REDUCE WATER USE BY 10% TO 20%**.



Landscape irrigation is limited to 2 days per week (June 1 to October 31); 1 day per week from (November 1 to May 31).



10 minutes per station per watering day



No irrigation during or within 72 hours of a rain event



Lawns may be watered between 8 p.m. and 10 a.m., when cooler temperatures minimize evaporation.



Repair or isolate leaks within 48 hours of notification by the City.



Pools and spas must be covered to prevent evaporation.



Car washing is allowed only with a bucket or a hose with shutoff valve or nozzle.



The following activities are **PROHIBITED**:



Washing sidewalks/driveways



Excessive irrigation runoff



Use of decorative water features such as fountains and ponds



Filling/refilling ornamental lakes/ponds (except to sustain aquatic life)
