

RESOLUTION 2024-16

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BANNING, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE CITY OF BANNING 2024-2029 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM CONSOLIDATED PLAN NEEDS ASSESSMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Banning has routinely secured grant funding under the Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") program through Riverside County Housing and Workforce Solutions ("HWS" on an annual basis; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") requires all jurisdictions receiving funding to perform and update a Five Year Consolidated Plan, which is conducted by HWS, as the City of a cooperating city; and

WHEREAS, on January 9, 2024, at its regular meeting, the City Council appointed an Ad-hoc committee to review input received from community engagement efforts and prioritize the City's needs for the next five years; and

WHEREAS, on January 5, 2024, the City issued a press release to local media posted as a legal notice and utilized all social media platforms to direct residents and business owners to the City's website to access the online survey; and

WHEREAS, the City conducted three community workshops, Saturday, January 20, 2024, at 9:00 am, Tuesday, January 23, 2024 at 6:00 pm, and Friday, January 26, 2024 at 2:00 pm. where hard copy surveys were available; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the survey results collected the ad-hoc committee set forth recommendations based upon the responses received (attachment A); and

WHEREAS, the City Council concurs with the ad-hoc committee and has set forth by this Resolution the following funding priorities; and

WHEREAS, the funding priorities meets the CDBG program guidelines and/or requirements for input to Riverside County's 2024-2029 Five Year Consolidated Plan and Needs Assessment; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the City periodically review and update its needs assessment and be approved by the City Council by Resolution in order for the City and its residents to obtain federally funded CDBG grant funds.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Banning as follows:


