


Egress Windows

Egress windows must be installed at all residential bedrooms unless the bedroom has an egress door.

These windows provide escape and rescue openings as is required by the California Building Code section 1031. The minimum clear opening must be 5.7 sq. ft. in total regardless of which way the window opens and provide a clear height of 24" and width of 20".

Emergency egress windows shall be installed a maximum of 44" above finish floor level and remain unobstructed. Security bars, grills, covers or screens must be removable from inside without tools or force greater than that required to open window. Windows below grade must have a permanent ladder or steps in window wells to allow egress.
