

All pool enclosure requirements must be in place at the time of pre-plaster inspection, before the pool is filled with water.


Door alarms must be listed for pool barrier use and mounted greater than 60" above finished floor.

Chiming door alarms or security alarms are not permitted.




No climbable walls or fences can be part of the pool barrier.

Add angled board if fence supports on exterior




Utility service lines must be relocated.
Or comply with Edison requirements

Gates must open outward from pool area and be self closing and self latching.

4 ft. maximum gate width per leaf.




5 ft. high fence or wall around entire perimeter minimum.



RV gates must be permanently locked with cane bolt lock at center to lock both sides.

All doors with access to pool area must be protected with alarms 85 db loud min that continuously sound until door is closed.



Gates and garage doors with access to pool enclosure must be self-closing and self latching.
