Incident: Shooting /Attempt Murder

On February 25, 2021, at approximately 4:21 pm, Banning Police Officers were dispatched to the San Gorgonio Memorial Hospital located at 600 N. Highland Springs, in the City of Banning, County of Riverside, for a report of a gun- shot victim who had arrived. Officers contacted the victim, who advised he had been shot while visiting Roosevelt Williams Park, located at 1101 E. George Street, in the City of Banning. Officers responded to the area of Roosevelt Williams Park and located evidence of a shooting. A crime scene was established, and the Banning Police Department Detective Bureau were summoned to scene and assumed the investigation.

Detectives were able to locate, document and collect evidence at the scene showing a violent encounter with the use of a firearm occurred; however, the Banning Police Department is asking for the public's help in identifying witnesses and suspects involved in this incident. Roosevelt Williams Park is a family park, where Citizens should feel safe to visit and have quality time with friends and family, not violent criminal activity.
